

Brief Profile of Mr. Arun Walia

Mr. Arun Walia, born on 3.7.1958, is Senior Additional Advocate General of the state of Haryana. He has also served as Senior Standing Counsel for Government of India, especially assigned by Union of India to deal with cases of All India Services like IAS, IPS etc.

Mr. Walia has attended several international conferences including the SAARCLAW Conference in Sri Lanka in 1999, where he presented a paper on “The Response of the SAARC countries to Combat Abuse of Women and Children”; the SAARCLAW Conference in Nepal in 2000 where he read a paper on “Enforcements of Foreign Judgments and awards in Indian Courts” and the Conference on Arbitration Law in Shanghai & Beijing (China) in June 2007.

Mr. Walia has the distinction of being nominated by His Excellency the Governor of Punjab, as non-official member of the Punjab & Town Planning & Development Board under Punjab Regional & Town Planning and Development Act, 1995.
