

Brief Profile of Hon'ble Sr. Justice I. Venkatanarayana

Sri Justice I. Venkatanarayana was born on 2nd April 1940 at Chittoor. He hails from Chittoor district. He had his early education at District Board High School, Chittoor and subsequently studied Intermediate in Pachiyappa's College, Madras University. He obtained his M. A. Degree in Economics from Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupathi and later did his L.L.B., at Delhi University. He hails from respectable family and his father Sri Inti Muniswamy Naidu was a leading at Chittoor. He joined the High Court Bar and was associated with Sri T. Anantha Babu, Senior Advocate and former Advocate-General. He is a member of the International Law Association and he represented the association at MONTREAL (CANADA) in 1982 and at WASHINGTON in 1992. He is also a Member of the Governing Council of the Indian Law Institute, New Delhi and Executive Chairman of the Council of the Indian Law Institute, A.P. State Unit and has successfully conducted two International Law Conferences on Human Rights & Child Labour. He is an Executive Member of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Proceedings. As a member of the International Association attended the conference at Berlin in August 2004. As a Senior Advocate he commanded large volume of work and argued a number of important cases on Constitution, Company Law and Taxation. He was a Standing Counsel for A. P. Housing Board and a number of Nationalized Banks and Companies.

Taking into consideration the volume of work he commanded, he was elevated as Judge of the High Court of Andhra Pradesh on 17th May 1999 and was made a Permanent Judge on 20th April 2000. In a short span of three years he had delivered a number of important judgments on civil law and service matters. He laid down the office as Permanent Judge of the High Court of Andhra Pradesh on 2nd April 2002. He took over as President of the A. P. State Commission he took keen interest in disposal of the complaints and appeals and the A.P. State Consumer Commission stood first in all India in disposal of cases. He laid down his office as President of the A.P. State Consumer Commission on 1-4-2007. Presently he is practicing as Senior Advocate in Supreme Court of India. He has also been appointed as Member Law Commission of India (part-time).
