He is a Graduate in Bachelor of Science (Chemistry and Agriculture). He is also a Bachelor of Law. Practiced as Lawyer for three years. Later got selected and the appointed to the elite Indian Police Service.

In that capacity held several positions including District Superintendent of Police of large problematic districts, like Gulbarga, Dharwar and Belgaum, major Districts of Karnataka State in India. He was also Director of Police Academy, Mysore, Karnataka.

He was Chief of Intelligence and Security of Karnataka State. He was DIG of Railway Police. Later in the Ministry Commerce of the Government of India, functioned as Director of Trade Promotion in Australia with headquarters in Sydney. On deputation in the Ministry of External Affairs of the Government of India, functioned as Diplomat and Head of Chancery and Consular Division of the Embassy of India in Moscow (then USSR).

He held challenging positions like Chief of Investigation of former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi assassination case; Director-General of Central Reserve Police Force, the largest para-military force in India and perhaps in the entire World; Director of the prestigious Central Bureau of Investigation of India; and Director-General in the National Human Rights Commission.
